

ISD MoCI/SCI Program Referral Process

1. Teacher, staff member or parent believes placement in an ISD program is most appropriate to meet student needs. This person will contact principal to begin process of determining appropriate placement.
2. Principal contacts ISD special education director who assigns appropriate ISD classroom teacher to observe student in current placement. Observation by ISD teacher must be completed prior to program referral staff meeting. Teacher contacts local district principal to inform them when observation is complete.
3. Principal schedules staffing to complete MoCI/SCI program referral staffing form.
 - a. Members needed for staffing: Principal, parents, general education teacher, resource room teacher, current ISD special education service providers, and ISD school psychologist.
4. Conduct staffing and team completes referral staffing form. If student does not meet criteria listed below they are not eligible for placement in either ISD program.
 - a. Criteria must be:
 - i. IQ of 69 or lower
 - ii. Reading and math scores off a standardized achievement test at the 6th percentile or lower
 - iii. Impairment of adaptive behavior
 - iv. All above criteria are adversely affecting students educational performance.
5. If current data supports programming in either ISD classrooms team will either complete a REED if further data is needed or schedule an IEP for change of placement.
6. If current data does not support programming in either ISD classroom team will schedule staffing to review students current program and develop a more appropriate program to meet students needs.
